FOREHEAD

"It appears Ashlee has had Botox to smooth her forehead and make her eyes more 'open,'" observes New York dermatologist Dr. David E. Bank. Cost: \$2,000 a year.

NOSE

"Her tip was shortened, slightly narrowed and rotated up," observes NYC plastic surgeon Dr. Victoria Karlinsky. "It gives her a more elegant look." Price tag? Up to a cool \$12K.

LIPS

"She has likely had filler injections such as Juvederm or Restylane [\$600 a pop] in her upper lip, resulting in a better size ratio between the upper and lower lip," shares Dr. Bank.

CHIN

Back in 2006, when Ashlee Simpson went under the knife to swap her prominent nose for a smaller, perkier one, she was hailed as Hollywood's best rhinoplasty samples surgery. Observers couldn't

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board for some additional noninvasive tweaks. "Ashlee's eyebrows are a bit more raised, which may be due to Botox," observes NYC plastic surgeon Dr. Victoria Karlinsky, who adds that Botox has also likely smoothed out "her forehead, 11 lines (the muscle between

the eyebrows) and crow's-feet." Her cheeks are not as full — probably due to being older and thinner — but her lips "have definitely been augmented, likely with fillers," says Dr. Karlinsky, who does not treat the star. Meanwhile, improved skin texture may be due to

"light laser resurfacing or peels," suggests Mount Kisco, New York, cosmetic dermatologist Dr. David E. Bank, who likewise does not call Ashlee a patient. Overall, notes Dr. Karlinsky, "She looks more refined, yet she still looks like herself!" **L&S**

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
